

SRA AGM 2020 1st April - Notice of Cancellation – 17/03/20

Dear Residents and friends of Selsdon,

As you are aware the extraordinary circumstances of the Covid-19 outbreak mean that there may be health risks associated with public gatherings. Whilst small gatherings are at the moment still permitted by the Government the advice is continually shifting. The SRA's first concern is for the benefit of residents and on this basis the SRA Executive felt it to be wise to take the precaution of cancelling this years AGM.

The SRA rules do not take account of such unprecedented events. It has been decided to publish the 2019 minutes with the reviewed Accounts in the April edition of the Gazette. Furthermore the Committee will continue this year, until the next AGM in 2021, on the basis of presumed consent of the following:

re-election of the Committee, approval of the increase of the SRA Subscription rate to £5 per annum and approval of the SRA and Gazette accounts.

In the light of the current circumstances it is hoped residents will be understanding and supportive of this decision.

In the meantime, with immediate effect, notices of the above will be placed on public Community Noticeboards, on the public local news feed 'Nextdoor', on the SRA website and the Hall door of St John the Divine (our usual AGM venue).

Furthermore we intend to continue to produce The Selsdon Gazette and place new monthly digital editions on our website **selsdon-residents.co.uk** Printed editions however may need to be suspended or collected from a central point depending on circumstances and health guidance. We will try to keep noticeboards and our website up to date with what is happening.
