Karen - Local Policing, specifically youths in Selsdon Rec not observing social distancing.

Linda - Concerns over the Planning situation in Croydon specifically Brick x Brick operations and all applications being approved and the apparent lack of democracy in the current planning approval meeting arrangements compared with Bromley
- Council finances: Croydon Council have the biggest debt of any London Borough and may declare bankruptcy. Auditors have been called in.

- What is the current situation re Croydon centre and Westfield development plans.
